	Sheriff elections being overly influenced by Federal interests. For example,	
	our current Sheriff worked as a sergeant in a Federally sponsored "Fusion	
	Center" within the Homeland Security Division of LASD, and he was staff to	
	Sheriff Lee Baca's Homeland Security Advisory Council that enlisted local	
	and foreign businessmen as "special reserves", yet most were later	
	identified as campaign donors to Baca and little else. Badges and guns for	
	unqualified donors became a public scandal, and all under the umbrella of	
	Federal Homeland Security funding. In 2020, I identified many former	
	Homeland Security Division supporters as campaign donors to our Sheriff.	
	The question arises then whether Federal Homeland Security interests	
	have any right to lobby or to be involved in funding County level
